### How can we help you?

*Miriam Learning Center (MLC) serves high school students who have academic or social challenges due to dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, ADHD and executive functioning challenges, language disorders, sensory integration disorder, auditory processing issues, and/or high functioning Autism. Many children who struggle in school who do not have a disability are also served.*

### DROP-IN HOMEWORK HELP

MLC's specialized teachers will help keep high schoolers on track with homework help. Drop in *anytime* at Miriam School Monday through Thursday from 5:00-7:00pm for small group assistance with math concepts, projects, writing, and homework completion. It's always more fun to get homework done when you are with friends and caring and knowledgeable teachers who can answer questions. \$100 per week, prepaid per month. A one-month minimum commitment is required.

### PRIVATE TUTORING

MLC tutors have the expertise to help high school students who have learning challenges. We have the experience to improve math, reading, writing, and organizational skills. One-hour private sessions are available at a student's home or school. Thirty, 45 and 60 minute tutoring sessions are available at Miriam School. Call for pricing and appointment availability.

## SOCIAL GROUP

High school is an exciting time to form life-long relationships. But it can also be very confusing; navigating the unspoken rules of a high school social climate. Miriam's Social Group provides strategies to help young adults understand the social nuances of high school, join into groups, and make and keep relationships. The Social Group meets for one hour each week, Thursdays 6:30-7:30pm at Miriam School. Classes start on the first Thursday of each month and continue throughout that month. Students may enroll for any month or multiple months. \$40 per weekly class (minimum one month commitment, prepaid).



## COUNSELING

Sometimes being a teenager is hard and they need some strategies to decrease anxiety, depression, anger, and other feelings that may be causing issues. Miriam's confidential counseling program is a supportive way to give young adults new tools to deal with things in their life that may be causing stress. Licensed professionals use Cognitive Behavioral Therapy to help students feel better. After school and early evening appointments are available at Miriam School. Miriam does not accept insurance but will provide you with documentation to submit to an insurance company. Call for availability.
