HIGH SCHOOL CAMPS

Entering Grades 9-12

High School Academic Training

High school students will learn strategies in a supportive and small group setting (6:1 student to teacher ratio) to continue improving reading and writing skills. Individualized instruction will help prepare students for the upcoming school year. Each student will also receive 30 minutes of daily 1:1 tutoring in either reading or writing.

The Social Teenager

Learn the best way to be a social teenager through group discussion and fun S.T.E.A.M. inspired activities. The group will collaborate about what topics need to be addressed based upon their current needs. Licensed and/or certified professionals will help teens further develop their social skills in order to create lasting friendships and fit within the high school culture (10:1 student to teacher ratio).

ACADEMIC CAMPS

Full-Day Camps

The Full-Day Academic Enrichment Camps infuse **reading, writing, and math** into **small group** S.T.E.A.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) inspired activities. Activities will be **fun while working on academic fundamentals**. Students will mostly be grouped by skill level (8:1 ratio).

S.T.E.A.M. Powered Teams

It takes a full crew to run the Miriam Express and the railway is looking for skilled workers to run the railroad. Through S.T.E.A.M. inspired activities that foster collaboration and positive social interactions, railway employees will take the “ride of their life” constructing a railroad and exploring new towns.

The Euro-Railway Adventure

Boxcar Slim, Miriam’s famous adventurer, is on a trip through Europe on the Miriam S.T.E.A.M. Express and he needs other adventurers to join his quest by making fondue in Switzerland, constructing a new Coliseum in Rome, and painting a Monet reproduction in France. Passengers will love this unique S.T.E.A.M. inspired European train ride.

Half-Day Camps

Academic Bootcamp

Passengers on this train ride will be pampered with individualized support, small group instruction in **reading, writing, and math**, a customized learning program created with research-based programs, and **30 minutes of daily 1:1 tutoring** in their own private railway car. Although campers will be challenged, they will have a wonderful time learning and creating memories (6:2 ratio).



Writing Skills Camp

Passengers on this trip should expect to work “all the live long day” but will have fun perfecting their **printing/cursive** and **typing skills**, and mastering ways to tackle engine breakdowns in **written expression and organization**. **Small groups** give travelers individualized attention to ensure their trip is enjoyable and worthwhile (6:1 ratio).



Reading Skills Camp

The Miriam Express railroad helps passengers get on the right **reading** track with **phonics, fluency and/or comprehension** with small group instruction (6:2 ratio), a customized program, and **30 minutes of daily 1:1 tutoring**. Activities are fun and are focused on SPIRE, Wilson, Rewards, and other research-based reading programs.

SOCIAL/EMOTIONAL SKILLS CAMPS

Full Steam Ahead Through Sports

Miriam’s S.T.E.A.M. Express passengers will show their speed and agility during this **non-competitive sports and games social skills** building camp. Through direct **social skills instruction** and sports and games, passengers will demonstrate skills to successfully interact with peers in a group setting (10:1 ratio).

The Calming Scenic View

Passengers who tend to be **shy, anxious or cautious** will learn ways to calm their body, soul and mind so they can enjoy the Miriam Express S.T.E.A.M. train ride and feel comfortable making friends. Therapist conductors will help passengers decrease **anxiety** through various therapeutic techniques and S.T.E.A.M. inspired activities (6:1 ratio).

Stop The Runaway Caboose

Sometimes passengers feel like a runaway caboose. The Miriam S.T.E.A.M. train will help them learn to take **control of their bodies and actions** so they can **get along with others and make friends** (6:1 ratio).

THERAPY CAMPS

Jumping The Tracks (Occupational Therapy)

The Miriam S.T.E.A.M. Express just jumped the tracks and is derailed. All passengers will use **sensory** input to stay calm and master **gross and fine motor** skills to maneuver to the next train stop. Fun S.T.E.A.M. inspired activities will help passengers get the train back on the tracks (6:1 ratio).

The Railroad Troupe (Social Language and Music Therapy)

Musicians and actors living on the Miriam Express will **write, produce and perform** a musical skit for other passengers on the train. Music Therapy troupe members will work on one **social language skill** through collaborative S.T.E.A.M. inspired **music therapy** activities (5:1 ratio).

How to Apply

Miriam Learning Center camps serve children of all abilities who can be successful within our staff ratios and within our level of expertise. Children must be able to independently participate in a camp within the designated camper to staff ratios. Campers must be independent with activities of daily living, free of toileting accidents, and should be able to verbally communicate at the sentence level.

First time campers please visit www.miriamstl.org, click on the summer camp tab and complete a summer camp application. New campers MUST provide evaluations reports and IEPs (if they have one) at the time of the application. Once we have received all of the documents, camp staff will contact you. All new campers will meet with camp staff prior to acceptance.

Payment

A \$250 deposit per camp is due when a child is accepted to camp. A \$50 deposit is required for each session of After Camp Care. Deposits are non-refundable after April 30, 2019. All camps must be paid in full by May 1, 2019 to secure a camper's spot. Those not paid in full may forfeit their child's camp placement. Due to small camp ratios, switching camps, sessions, or refunds will not be made after April 30th. Limited scholarships are available on a first come first served basis for those who qualify.
